HARASSMENT in custody issues

In accordance with our Safety Policy St Pius X OSHC is committed to providing a safe, non-threatening environment for its staff and children, particularly when dealing with conflicts arising through custody issues.

When a parent insists on taking a child against the other parent's authority we will undertake the following procedure:

- 1. Tell the parent we haven't been advised of the access visit and we must ring the custodial parent for verification.
- 2. Try to avoid conflict and don't argue in front of the child/ren.
- 3. Ask the parent to sign the children out.
- 4. Ring the parent to advise the children have been taken. It is up to the parent to call the police.
- 5. If the parent can't be contacted, ring police directly and advise them a child has been taken from our care without permission.
- 6. If there is a restraining order in place ring the police directly, immediately.
