

POLICY STATEMENT ON HEALTH AND SAFETY

The St Pius X OSHC Service aims to provide a safe, healthy environment in which children can play and explore their world free from harm and staff can perform their duties in a safe manner. Risk assessments will be implemented to maintain a safe environment. Products used in the service will be assessed for hazards and stored appropriately. In the event of an accident, appropriate first aid or cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) will be applied by trained staff. If an emergency or natural disaster occurs at the service the children and staff will be well practiced in the procedures required to ensure the safety and wellbeing of everyone present, as far as possible.
